## GREATER GRAND RAPIDS AREA PLAQUE ATTACK

## Rules of Engagement

- 1. Only groups that are members of GGRASCNA may participate.
- 2. In order for a group to capture a Group Plaque, 2 or more members of a Homegroup must attend another meeting that currently has a Group Plaque. The Group Plaque is not about prestige. It is about NA unity in the GGRASCNA, one home group supporting another home group.
- 3. The Group Plaque cannot be captured/passed until the meeting is over. It is recommended that the capture take place after the closing. At no time should the capture of the Group Plaque interrupt the primary purpose of Narcotics Anonymous meetings. All home group members attempting to capture a plaque must be in the meeting from the opening of the meeting to the closing of the meeting. You may only capture the home Group Plaque, not the plaques they have captured from other groups.
- 4. <u>If more than one home group attends the meeting and wants to capture the Group Plaque,</u> the determining factor as to who gets the Group Plaque will be the group that has the newest <u>member</u>.
- 5. The Group's Plaque and any captured Group Plaques should be displayed at the home group meeting.
- 6. Once a group's home Group Plaque has been captured, the group may recapture their home Group Plaque by following steps 2-4 above.
- 7. At no time should a capture be refused as long as the above conditions are met. Have fun!
