Please remember if your group or subcommittee is holding an event or has a flyer to disperse it needs to go through the Area Web Servant first for approval before being shared, posted and distributed. This was a decision made by the ASC body in 7.2016 to

ensure our flyers have all required information listed before it goes out to the fellowship. This is for the purpose of making sure all necessary details like address is correct, correct name of Area, date, time, contact and registered NA symbol to present. This is in no way to judge your artistic ability! We just want to ensure all flyers have a guide they follow. If you need a list of what should be listed on a flyer here it is:

- o A specific date, time and location name with address
- "Northwestern Michigan Area of Narcotics Anonymous" included somewhere to show it's based in our NW Area
- o Narcotics Anonymous symbol WITH registration symbol somewhere on flyer
- o A contact person listed, including their phone number, for questions or more information
- Mention if it's a "free event" or a monetary "fee" or a "donation based" event and always include "No Addict Turned Away" if money is fee based/donation based and required at entry
- Submit ALL flyers to the Area Web servant (Megan S.) for prior approval <u>BEFORE</u> circulating at any meetings or posting on FB. After sharing the flyer with the Web servant, once approved, it will then be uploaded to our UpNorthNA Area Website in a timely manner.

After the flyer is checked I will give you the go ahead to share and print it and will then post it on our website. I will not be looking on social media platforms for flyers for a few reasons- 1. ain't nobody got time for that and I'll miss some and 2. When downloaded from social media sites it degrades the quality and comes out blurry when posted to the website. Please know I remove all contact phone numbers from a flyer before putting it on the website so there's no need for you to alter it, just send it to me as you'd print it to disperse at meetings.
