RD/RDA Summary

The HRP is tasked with identifying members who apply the principles of our program, leadership qualities, and ability to perform the tasks relevant to the specific service position for nomination at the WSC: WSC Cofacilitator, Human Resource Panel member, and World Board member. The HRP does not directly participate in Fellowship Development. They rely on the regional service committees, zonal forums, and the World Board to develop and recommend potential candidates for consideration for nomination at the World Service Conference through the "RBZ" (Region, World Board, Zonal Forum) process.

RBZ Questions

- How have you shown consistency and follow-through in service?
- What challenges do you have when functioning as part of a team?
- What do you do to prepare for a service meeting?
- What do you know about the position you are interested in?
- What experience or knowledge do you have regarding NA World Services?
- Why should we recommend you for this role?

If this service body wants to make a recommendation for these positions at WSC 2026, our delegates can make a submission between October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025. More information on the HRP and the RBZ process can be found at na.org/conference.
