Literature had a starting balance of \$500.39, Income of \$512.00, income from transfer of \$120.55, expenses of \$842.75, with the new balance of \$290.19.

Our subcommittee has started fundraising already for the upcoming years NWACNA and it is our goal to

hold an event monthly between now and August 2023 to raise as much funds as possible. If any other subcommittees or home groups are interested in pairing up with us in support of Retreat fundraising please let me know! We would be happy to combine with any groups to facilitate auctions, specific merch sales, etc during any other planned events in the area!

Our current retreat balance is still holding at \$1500.00 per our allotted seed money.

We held our first NWACNA fundraiser Pancake Breakfast this weekend and had a surprising turn out despite the crappy weather! We raised \$261.75 total in donations. \$7.75 donated via Venmo and \$194.00 in cash donations. We donated \$50.00 to Church of the Nazarene for use of the facility and an

additional \$10.00 for use of their supplies such as oil, paper towel, dishes, soap, etc. So our total donation to the church was \$60.00. This was documented by our subcommittee's treasurer and was taken out of our raised cash funds and given to the church. This leaves us with \$194.00 in cash today to

turn into our Area Treasurer and \$7.75 in Venmo funds to be transferred to the Area account.

We also have been dispersing our "NWACNA26 Name the Retreat" boxes to the biggest meetings in our

area. If all home groups can make sure to display them during their meetings and announce them during

NA announcements! We are asking for recovery-related names for our upcoming NWACNA 26 and will

be collecting the buckets in December or January so names can be voted on. If your name/idea is chosen
