Hospital and Institution

The Women and Men of H&I are doing alright. Support for the women in the jail struggles some weeks but is being worked out with the women's jail liaison. The next orientation for the Washtenaw County Jail will be held April 13th at 9:00 a.m. in the learning resource center.

This past month, the PR subcommittee attended Western Wayne's H&I subcommittee meeting. We will continue to attend until the Huron Valley Women's Prison rotation is up and running. We have collected more forms in Washtenaw County and are still looking for more women to go in to the prison. The goal is to have a rotation of women going in starting in either March or April. We will find out more at the next Western Wayne H&I meeting next Sunday.

Past Month

The PR subcommittee recently purchased 3 tier IP holders to place at facilities in the community. Two of the IP holders have been placed in facilities. One was placed at the hope clinic. I met a contact by the name of Debbie who was excited to have the information at their facility. The other holder was placed at UMATS, which is the University of Michigan's Addiction Services. The lady at the front desk took the rack and told me she would pass it along to her director. After I left the facility I followed my visit up with an email to provide a contact for them in case they have any questions. Also, we stopped by the probation office in Ann Arbor and made sure the rack there was stocked and had updated meeting lists. The last IP holder will hopefully be placed at Eastern Michigan's SNOW Health building. The PR committee also participated in last month's Michigan Region PR Zoom meeting. This is a web conference with the PR chair for the Michigan Region along with PR chair from around the state.

One thing that was discussed on the PR Zoom meeting was the first annual PR week which will be held the first week of June 2019. This leaves the PR committee \$34.95 which will be used to buy more of the IPs. The \$45.05 worth of IPs was all that MSO could sell us at the time and they have been placed in our IP holders around the county.



Regional Committee Member (RCM)

- Provides two-way communication with the MIchigan Region
- May serve on Sub-Committees, but not as a Chair
- Must provide a thorough report from the MRSCNA meetings
- Must be prudent in travel and lodging, access to transportation will be needed

Regional Committee Member Alternate (RCMA)

- Minimum one year continuous abstinence from all drugs
- spends the first year becoming familiar with the job of the RCM, performing the duties of the RCM's in his/her absence
- Must attend all WASC MEETINGS AND MRSCNA meetings, when approved by WASC
- Must be prudent in travel and lodging, access to transportation will be needed
