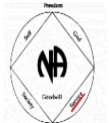

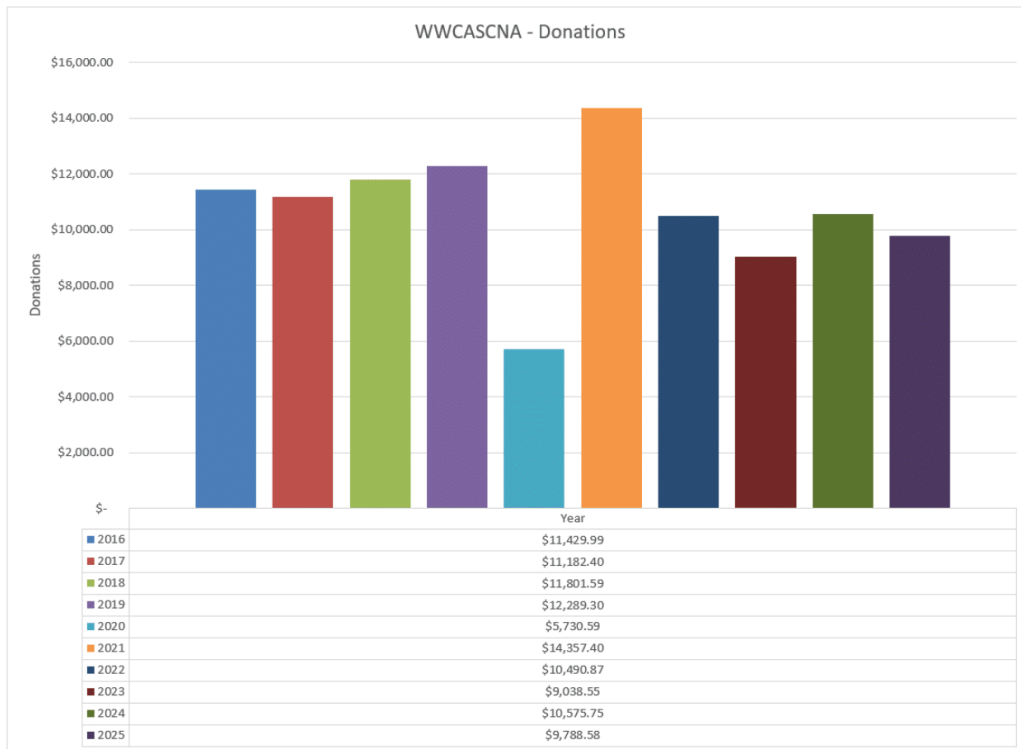

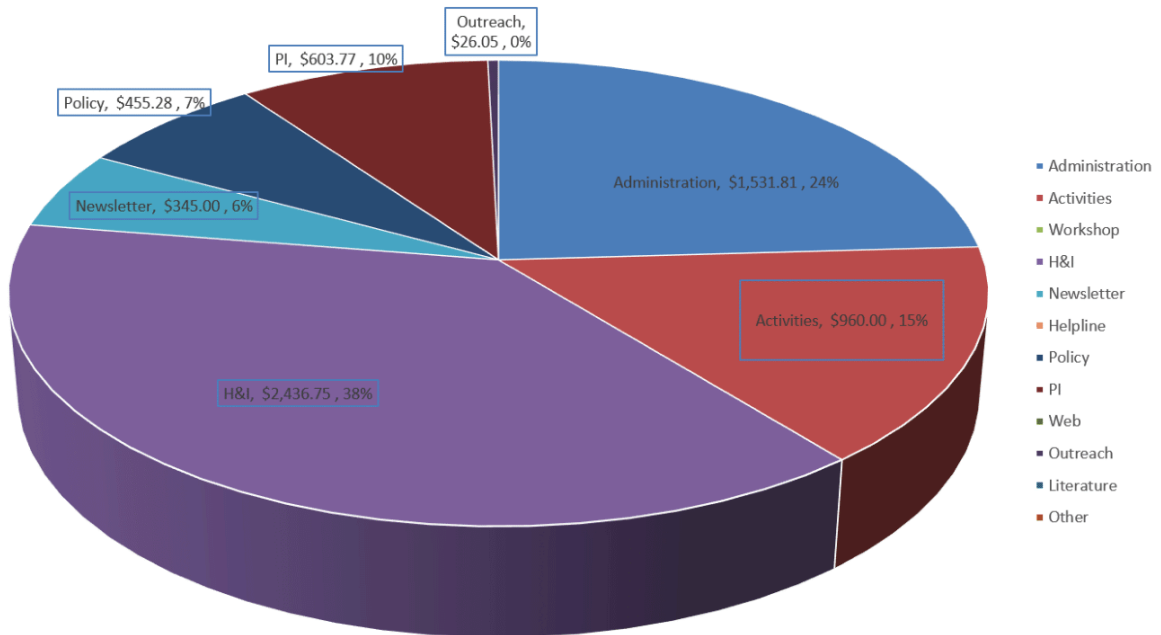
3. Historical Donations Chart

4. 2025 Fund Dispersed Chart

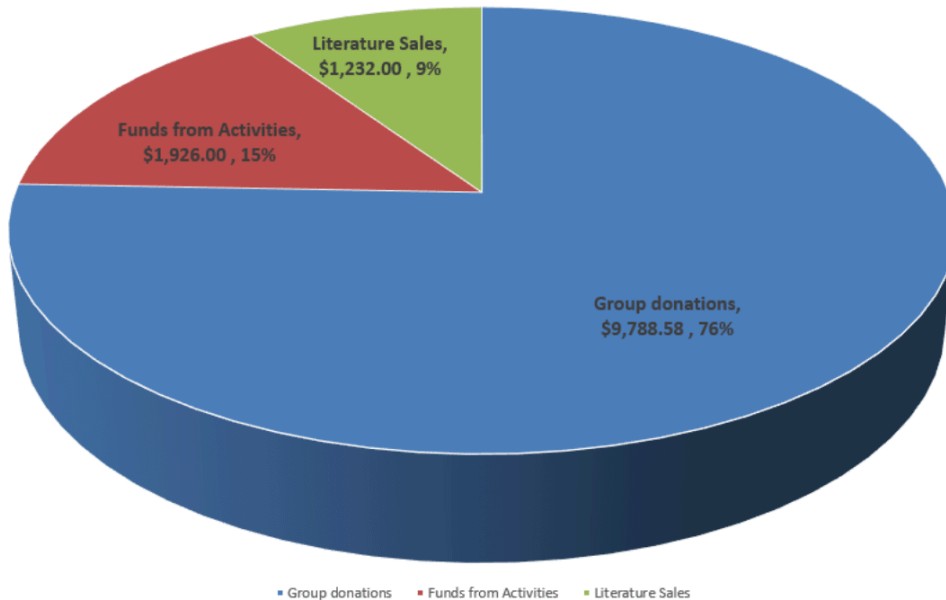
2025 Funds Dispersed by WWCASCNA
